Dear Saints of Grace.

Usually this time of year is one of excitement. We're winding up summer and looking with anticipation to gearing up and getting things back to their full swing. In that vein, I normally write a newsletter article listing all of the things for the year that will be starting up again. This year, however, as we all know is different. This letter will still be all the things that are getting going again, but with our unique circumstances, I think instead of gearing back up, we're gearing back up-ish. In any case, here are the things that are coming back.

First, on September 16th, we'll kick off our Wednesday Morning Bible Class at 9:00 A.M. again. We'll be starting back where we were in the letter to the Hebrews. The class will meet in the Fellowship Hall, but if that ends up getting crowded, we can always move to the sanctuary for more space. Ordinarily, I like to reserve the sanctuary for the service itself, to designate that what happens in our Lord's coming to us in Word and Sacrament is a unique circumstance, but as unusual as things are, the usual sometimes has to change. That's Wednesdays.

For Sunday Mornings, we'll start with a joint Sunday School and Bible Class meeting on September 20th beginning at 9:15. This will be outside, and we will have everyone grouped at tables by families. This will kick off how we'll be doing Sunday School this year, which will be a bit different. Our plan for Sunday School will be that we will meet in person outside one Sunday in September and one in October. On the Sundays in between we will not meet in person for Sunday School (we will meet for Adult Bible Class, but more on that to come). These weeks in between will be filled in with materials for at home lessons with individual families. This will include a reading, some questions, and activities planned by our Sunday School teachers (thanks to them in advance for their help!). As November and December roll around we will assess the in person aspect of meeting, and be in contact about that. While this is certainly out of the ordinary for Sunday School, I am excited at the prospect of whole families gathering together to talk about Our Lord. Time and time again it is shown that parents are the greatest influence on their children's faith.

The Sunday following our Sunday School opening, we will have our ordinary Adult Bible Class. Again this will meet in the Fellowship Hall unless attendance dictates we move to the sanctuary. Our topic beginning on September 27th will be a new book from CPH called <u>Faith in the Shadow of the Pandemic.</u> This book is authored by John Pless, a professor of mine from seminary, and Jacob Corzine, a new member at Grace who is a theology professor at Concordia University Chicago. Dr. Corzine has graciously offered to help me in teaching from the book. He will teach the chapters he wrote and I will teach the chapters written by Dr. Pless.

So as we see the usual things starting back up to a degree, as we are gearing back up-ish, we pray that we would always be drawn to the hearing of the Lord's Word and the comfort of His promises. We pray this especially in the challenges that we face in our current time. We know that no matter what happens, He is gracious and merciful, caring for us far more than we can ask or imagine.


