Dear Saints of Grace,

We have something exciting happening here on May 16th. On that day, we will have six of our youth going through the Rite of Confirmation. Thanks be to God! As we give thanks for those children and the joy that we have in their confirming the faith given to them in their baptism, it's a good time for all of us to reflect on the vows of confirmation. In view of that, I've included that questions our confirmands will be asked. This may not be exactly what you vowed at your confirmation, but it's edifying to consider these nonetheless:

- P Do you this day in the presence of God and of this congregation acknowledge the gifts that God gave you in your Baptism?
- R Yes, I do.
- **P** Do you renounce the devil?
- R Yes, I renounce him.
- **P** Do you renounce all his works?
- R Yes, I renounce them.
- **P** Do you renounce all his ways?
- R Yes, I renounce them.
- P Do you believe in God the Father Almighty?
- **R** Yes, I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.
- P Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord?
- Yes, I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.
- **P** Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?
- Yes, I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.
- P Do you hold all the prophetic and apostolic Scriptures to be the inspired Word of God?
- \mathbb{R} I do.
- Do you confess the doctrine of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, drawn from the Scriptures, as you have learned to know it from the Small Catechism, to be faithful and true?
- R I do.
- P Do you intend to hear the Word of God and receive the Lord's Supper faithfully?
- I do, by the grace of God.
- P Do you intend to live according to the Word of God, and in faith, word, and deed to remain true to God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, even to death?
- **R** *I do, by the grace of God.*
- P Do you intend to continue steadfast in this confession and Church and to suffer all, even death, rather than fall away from it?
- **R** *I do, by the grace of God.*

As I reflect on those questions, on the of the most comforting aspects I find are the words, "by the grace of God." As we vow the things we vow there, as our youth vow the things they vow there, those words point us to the realization that this is not a work we do on our own. It is always grounded in the grace of our God. In light of that, then, we turn to that grace, and grasp it in the knowledge that it is required every step of the way. Man truly does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God. As that Word speaks the forgiveness and life of the cross to us, may He grant us that grace by which we, and our confirmands, live always in that resurrection victory of Christ.


