Dear Saints of Grace,

As we come to April once more, we also come to the celebration of our Lord's resurrection at Easter. While many years come with a connection of the spring and the new life that we see in them with the Lord's new life after the tomb, this year doesn't appear to want to spring to that new life. But whether the weather reflects it or not, just as with Christmas, we can still consider what we're celebrating, despite our associations with the time of year. And with this holiday, we get to joyfully celebrate the resurrection of Jesus as He stepped forth from the tomb showing us our forgiveness and life and salvation.

As we explore our Lenten theme of "Views of Jesus at the Cross," Holy Week and Easter will continue that discussion on Good Friday and Easter Sunday. On Good Friday, we will look at Jesus as the Atonement for our sins, what atonement means and the like, and how the cross shows us what that means. Then on Easter Sunday, we'll conclude with talking about Jesus as is our Victor, and in the resurrection, we see that Jesus has won the victory for us there. He has defeated our enemies of sin, death, and the devil.

Without getting too in depth, we understand that we are held captive by sin to sin itself. We can't help but sin, and we are thereby guilty so our experience in this life reflects that captivity. The guilt of sin brings with it suffering and death. We can't escape that. Finally, this all comes at the hands of the devil who has taken us captive by them. As Christ suffers for our sin, takes our place under its wrath, and dies for it, it is paid for. He has done it all, and now we all are free by His resurrection. We have life in Him.

Not only that, but we have life as He gives it to us in the waters of baptism. You see, your baptism connects to that first Easter. As Paul says, "You were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised by the glory of the Father, you too walk in newness of life." In those waters, you, and your sin with you, were buried in the tomb of Jesus. With that union, you were also raised with Him to new life. This means you have the forgiveness of our sins, and the joy that brings to you eternally. It also means that you live in the goodness of freedom from sin in this life as well. You are baptized and live in the victory of Jesus for you. Thanks be to God!

As we reflect on that now and at Easter, I pray the joy of that message brings you peace and comfort in every walk of your life. As the cooler weather and the clouds seem like they'll be with us perpetually, that still brings brightness and warmth. May it bring that to you in all things.


