Dear Saints of Grace.

Do you sometimes listen to the Gospel reading on Sunday morning or read the words of Jesus in your Bible and wonder what Jesus is saying? We can be honest that there are definitely quotes from Jesus that make us wonder exactly what he is saying. One example I always think of is when Jesus heals the daughter of the Syrophoenician woman. If you remember that story, it's from Mark 7 where the woman comes to Jesus and begs for Him to hear her. At first, He ignores her. Then, He says it's not right to "take the children's bread and give it to the dogs" (Mark 7:27). Finally, He agrees and gives the mother what she asks. Jesus acts in such a confusing way in this story, doesn't He? He says things that seem so contrary to what we expect from Him.

For our book reading this summer, we'll be examining that topic of wondering what Jesus is saying. To do this we'll be reading "Jesus Said What?" by Christopher M. Kennedy. In the book, Kennedy examines fifteen passages from the Gospels where Jesus says things that cause many to take a step back and ask just what our Lord means by His words. The fifteen selections Kennedy has chosen include references to hating one's family, Jesus not bringing peace but a sword, and there being no marriage in heaven. He also includes the passages where Jesus describes making friends with "unrighteous wealth," cutting off one's hand, and the "unforgiveable sin," as well as nine more times when Jesus said things that often make people wonder about His words.

With this in mind, we invite you to join us for our discussions of the book. As a note, our first meeting will be on the last *Monday* in June and not on the usual Wednesday. I have the conference for our youth in Wisconsin Tuesday through Friday of that week. So, we will gather Monday, June 24th. In July and August, we will revert to our usual Wednesday meetings. These will take place Wednesday, July 31st and Wednesday, August 28th. All of the discussions will begin at 7:00 P.M. on their respective evenings.

In addition to this, as always, I encourage you to utilize the summertime to reorient yourself around the Word of God in your daily life. Often with the hecticness of the rest of summer, we can shift our attention to the things of the world, the things that aren't inherently bad and sinful, but can distract us from our Heavenly Father's love and grace to us in Christ. Likewise, I encourage you if you're traveling, to make plans on where to go to attend the Divine Service on your trip. If you need help with that, please let me know, as I have resources I can search to aid in finding something similar to what we usually have on Sunday morning at Grace.

In all of this, our study of Jesus' hard sayings, and the activities of summer, I pray the Lord to be with you and keep you in the everlasting comfort that is ours in Christ and His life, death, and resurrection for us!


